Mr. Williams,

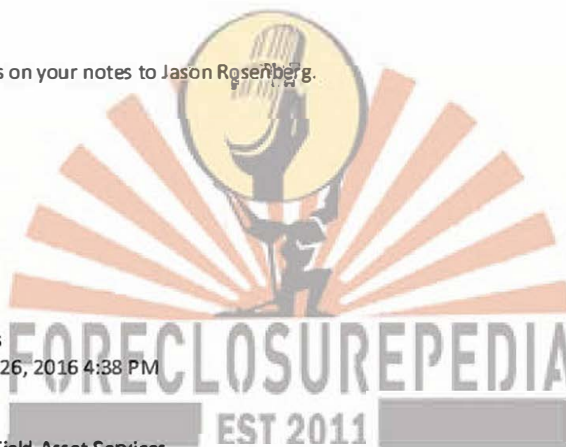
